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ВВЕДЕНИЕ

В сборники - нотные издания серии «Ансамбли классических гитар. Избранные лёгкие пьесы» включены произведения для ансамблей шестиструнных гитар различных составов, рассчитанные на изучение: учащимися ДМШ, ДШИ, студентами музыкальных учебных заведений различного уровня, любителями гитары.

Здесь понятие «лёгкие пьесы» объясняется следующими характеристиками музыкального материала: возможность исполнения ряда сочинений исполнителями, не так давно взявшими в руки гитару; достаточно понятное для слухового восприятия, как мелодико-гармоническое, так и ритмическое изложение; а также все композиции будут интересны для начинающих с точки зрения художественной ценности и смогут украсить любой концерт.

Отличительной особенностью сборников является то, что в них будут публиковаться пьесы не только композиторов-классиков, но и современных авторов, не известные широкому кругу учащихся, преподавателей. В связи с этим данные нотные издания рекомендуются в качестве методических пособий педагогам образования различного уровня.

В третий выпуск входят сочинения, написанные для дуэта гитар.

По традиции, открывает издание классика - произведение «Рондо» одного из крупнейших английских композиторов Генри Пёрселла. Далее идут «Десять очень лёгких дуэтов» современного английского композитора, руководителя субботней музыкальной школы и коротких курсов в Лидском музыкальном колледже Карен Гурлэй, и, ввиду того, что в партии каждой гитары только одноголосие с простым ритмом, исполнять их ученики смогут уже с первых шагов своей музыкальной деятельности.

Далее - аранжировка пьесы знаменитого мексиканского композитора Мануэля Понсе «Эстреллита» («Звёздочка»). Необходимо отметить, что на многие из его произведений сильно повлияли гармония и форма традиционных песен, что отчётливо прослеживается в данном сочинении, имеющего очень красивую мелодическую основу.

Продолжение - аранжировка популярной композиции 19-го века «Мимолётное счастье» немецкого автора Иды Прэйд, с также запоминающейся песенной мелодией.

Лёгкий жанр представлен популярнейшим креольским танго Анхеля Виллольдо «El Choclo» (Эль Чокло - кукурузный початок). Интересно, что композитор - ресторанный музыкант из Буэнос-Айреса, — сочинил, наверное, это самое знаменитое аргентинское танго примерно в 1903 году, и уже через некоторое время этот танец приобрёл феноменальную популярность в Европе, после первого выпуска пластинки в Париже в 1910-м году. А в 1911-м году пластинка попадает в Россию, после чего там начинается повальное увлечение модным танго. Дело дошло до того, что министерство просвещения Российской империи запретило учащимся и студентам посещать танцклассы, где преподавался этот «неприличный» танец.

Далее - сочинения двух современных белорусских композиторов - Зинаиды Смирновой и Светланы Ветушко. Начинающих музыкантов порадуют незатейливые мотивы с содержанием явно игровой направленности, которые особенно любят совсем юные ученики.
